

# Environmental Monitoring Technician

### **Role location:**

The role would be based in London with travel required across the UK for specific project opportunities.

### **The role:**

Daily duties will include the remote checking of monitors to ensure they are operating within specified parameters, resolving faults through liaison with equipment suppliers and communication with our in-house technical team and project managers.

You will ensure that all work is delivered to the highest standards and in line with published procedures and have a strong focus on health, safety and the environment. Data will be recorded and provided to the project team for analysis and reporting.

This is an exceptional opportunity at an exciting time both for our business and for environmental consultancy. We will train you to collect samples and data using relevant equipment and record such data as appropriate, including with the use of smart phone or tablet technology. The job will involve driving, lifting and carrying equipment, alongside deploying and collecting samples. You will need to follow operational guidance and adhere to current Health and Safety procedures.

Much of the work is focused on London and the south-east, but you must be happy to work across the UK from time to time to suit business needs with occasional overnight stays. You must be flexible with regards to out of hours and occasional weekend work – additional hours worked would be given back in lieu at a time to suit the business.
